ABSTRAK

It is written in Bahasa Indonesia. *Abstrak* must be integrated and independent which consists of *Latar belakang, Tujuan, Metode, Hasil, and Kesimpulan* is written vividly, intact, and complete. *Abstrak* must be written using until 200 words maximum which has no reference and accompanied by *Kata kunci*. It should be written using Calibri 11, with single spacing.

KATA KUNCI

Kata kunci should not more than 5 words. It should be written using Calibri 11 with single spacing.

ABSTRACT

It is written in English. Abstract must be integrated and independent which consists of Background, Objective, Methods, Results, besides the Conclusion is written vividly, intact, and complete. Abstract must be written using until 200 words maximum which has no reference and accompanied by keywords. It should be written using Calibri 11, with single spacing.

Results must be written using Calibri 11 and Bold. The content consists of the data and information that has been collected. The finding systematically must be supported by charts, tables, or informative illustrations. It should be written using Calibri 11 with single spacing.

TABLES

Each table must be typed using Calibri 10 or customized with single spacing. Tables’ numbers are sorted in order of mention in the text (written numbers do not use punctuation dot "."). Tables are given a title and subtitle briefly. Tables’ title is written in Calibri 11, bold (first sentence must be capital letter) with single spacing. Single spacing between tables’ title and the tables. Double spacing between sentences in the last paragraph and tables’s title and double spacing between the last paragraph and the next paragraph. If there is a caption, it is written using Calibri 8, single

spacing and also single spacing between the tables and the tables' caption. The columns in the tables are written without vertical lines. Explanation of Non-standard abbreviations in the tables are placed in footnotes.

FIGURES

Each figure must have a label on the back and contains a number of figures, the authors' name, and sign instructions "top" figures. Figures' title is placed below the figures. The figures must be numbered in accordance with the appearance in the text. Moreover the graphs and diagrams are considered as figures. Background of the graphs and diagrams are plain. If there is a caption, it should be written after the figures' title.

DISCUSSION

It is written using Calibri 11 and Bold. The content consists of the discussion about the finding. It should be written using Calibri 11 with single spacing.
